Calendar review:

Financial review:

- We had a negative balance for January but February is a chance for us to make money;
- Will focus our efforts of closed shops to clean up bikes and organize them in order to sell them; streamlining our bookkeeping;

WCBC financial donation:

Possibility for the WCBC to sponsor NBP, interested in continuing contributions;

- Purchased our tools for \$500-600; also gave us Bob Wheeler's items, donated to UBP;
- What can we have sponsored?;
- Can be for programming or physical items; safety lights, find cheap ones and create plan for 100 per month; QBP, how to customize them;
- Brochure printing; buttons, magnets and stickers;
- Packages they can fund; youth program; small flyer with strong website; bells, law for audible warning; goodie packs for owners; safety package, banner with safety information, bells, lights; look up costs of lights and bells, banner about \$70,

Security update:

- Purchased key locking contraption; finding someone who can put together the lights and installation; Tom and Steve,
- Front light is easy, side light is mercury light that is hanging, can work, the light on the side opposite the lot;
- Tom and Steve can also put a light on the side; prioritize front and side; could be good to mount another light;

Ebay account:

- New account set up;
- If we get a Missionfish account, all we need UBP's 501c3 paperwork and a sheet that says that we are sponsored by them;
- Lets wait to sell stuff on Ebay for that setup;
- Ebay waives fees from Missionfish; easier to set up our own rather than going through UBP and making it complicated;
- Need to get forms from UBP
- UBP fiscal sponsorship great for us, nothing that we want to do by not having our own 501c3, if we had to do that it would be \$850 and much paperwork
